











## THE STORY

Through their Curate Enfield grassroots public art programme, Enfield Council partnered with local 'public art champions' to create a public art commission for the main town centre of Palmers Green. Public Art Champions, Lydia, Nidal and Aykut, with the guidance of local artist-mentor Alex McHallam, created an artist's brief for a series of murals which celebrated the high street and Palmers Green's unique identity. Following an open call for submissions, the group selected The Matchbox Collective to create and install the murals. The Matchbox designed the murals in collaboration with community groups including the NHS Wellbeing Group at Broomfield Park Community Orchard, Philanthropy CIC, Ruth Winston Community Centre and YR 10 students from Laurel Park School. Huge thanks to all the people who participated in these and shared their wonderful and creative ideas, and to The Friends of Broomfield Park, Palmers Green Action Team and Starfish Loves Coffee for the additional support and guidance.

The work generated during the community workshops was developed by Matchbox artists Ellie Fryer, Will Redgrove, Bec Dennison and Gavin McPhail and installed as vibrant public paintings exploring themes of Biodiversity, Identity and Heritage
